



# 2014-2015 PROFILE

### **TYPE**

Alcorn State University is a land-grant, residential University. It is one of eight state-assisted institutions of higher learning in the state of Mississippi.

### **LOCATION**

The University is located in Claiborne County, Mississippi, five miles west of Lorman, 12 miles southwest of Port Gibson, and 40 miles south of Vicksburg, Mississippi. State Highway 552 forks off from U.S. Highway 61 one mile north of north of Lorman, Mississippi, and leads directly to the campus.

## **PHYSICAL FACILITIES**

The University encompasses 1,756 acres, of which 300 acres make up the campus and athletic fields, and 1,456 acres are devoted to agriculture and research. Built on a gentle slope, the carefully campus is landscaped. with green carpeted grass. surrounded by attractive shrubbery. Towering trees, many more than one hundred years old, distinctive with Spanish moss, shade the grounds and enhance the picturesque setting in which auiet studv and worthv companionship are fostered. 






### IN-STATE ENROLLMENT BY COUNTY FALL 2014


### IN-STATE ENROLLMENT BY COUNTY SPRING 2015





## ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY DEGREES AWARDED BY SCHOOL, GENDER AND ETHNICITY 2014-2015










### ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY FULL-TIME FACULTY: PERCENTAGE BY SCHOOL





## FULL-TIME INSTRUCTIONAL FACULTY: PERCENTAGE BY SCHOOL





### ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY EDUCATIONAL AND GENERAL EXPENDITURES FISCAL YEAR 2014











## ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY FUNDING SOURCE FISCAL YEAR 2014








